Health & Safety Policy

Fresh Start Eco Cleans



This Health and Safety Policy Statement has been adopted and agreed by Fresh Start Eco Cleans Ltd (the 'Company') as its general statement of intent regarding health and safety and is an integral part of the Health and Safety Policy.

The Company recognises and accepts the responsibility as an employer for providing a safe and healthy workplace and working environments for all employees and to protect, so far as is reasonably practicable, all persons who may be affected by any of its activities.

The Company will aim take all reasonable steps to meet this responsibility, paying particular attention to the provision and maintenance of:

- Plant, equipment, and systems of work that is safe and without risks to health.
- Safe arrangements for the use, handling, storage and transport of articles and substances.
- Sufficient information, instruction, training, and supervision to enable all employees to avoid hazards and contribute positively to their own health and safety at work.
- A safe place of work with safe access and egress.
- A healthy working environment with adequate welfare facilities.

The Company has undertaken to provide competent technical advice on health and safety matters and further advice may be sought from senior management.

All levels of management and all employees are expected to co-operate as far as is possible with the Company to enable it to carry out the requirements of the Health and Safety Policy is policy.

Employees have a responsibility to take reasonable care of their own health and safety, and that of other persons who may be affected by their acts or omissions at work.

Note: This policy statement will be reviewed annually, and as and when necessary. For example: when there are significant changes in the workplace, after a legitimate request or when legislation requires it.
